Call for Nominations

Dear CU Boulder Faculty member,

You are receiving this email because, as a member of the <u>CU Faculty Senate</u> body, you have the opportunity to nominate yourself or a colleague to a seat on a Standing Committee on the Boulder Faculty Assembly (BFA), the representative body of the faculty in the shared governance of the CU-Boulder campus.

The nominations process begins on Monday, September 9, 2024, and continues through Wednesday, September 18th. Once nominations have closed, the current members of the BFA will vote on the nominees; this election will take place between September 19-20.

I strongly encourage you to consider nominating yourself or a colleague to a standing committee. BFA Standing Committees undertake important work on behalf of the faculty and others in the community on the CU Boulder campus. The chart below indicates available Committee seats.
