Rates published by the Bursar's Office are approved by the Board of Regents. The Board of Regents reserves the right to change tuition and fees at any time. Tuition charged is based on residency classification, number of credit hours and your college, school or program. Fractional credit hours outside of flat rate tuition are assessed the average rate between the two closest credit hours. Dual degrees are charged the higher rate. These rates apply to Boulder Main Campus only. Classes taken on different campuses and Continuing Education incur separate tuition and fees. Rates and deadlines may be subject to change.

Online Billing

- Tuition and fees are billed each semester.
- Bills are issued online only.
- Students can access their student account information and the bill in Buff Portal once they are enrolled.
- Parents and family members do not automatically have access to view the student account and the bill, but students can authorize them as payers to view and pay the bill in CUBill&Pay.

Make Payments Easier with Payment Plans

- CU Boulder offers interest-free payment plans each semester and in the summer.
- Allows you to pay the university bill in smaller, more manageable monthly installments.
- Students sign up for payment plans in Buff Portal and authorized payers sign up in CUBill&Pay.
