Rates published by the Bursar's Office are approved by the Board of Regents. The Board of Regents reserves the right to change rates at any time. Tuition charged is based on residency classification, degree and number of credit hours. Fractional credit hours outside of flat rate tuition are assessed the average rate between the two closest credit hours. Dual degrees are charged the higher rate. These rates apply to Boulder Main Campus only. Classes taken on different campuses including Boulder Main Campus and Continuing Education incur separate tuition and fees and are billed separately. Rates and deadlines may be subject to change.

¹ Tuition is assessed on a linear credit hour basis (each credit hour is the same rate). Tuition continues to increase at the same increment for each hour over 18.
