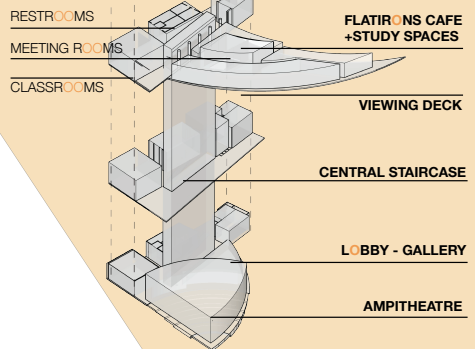
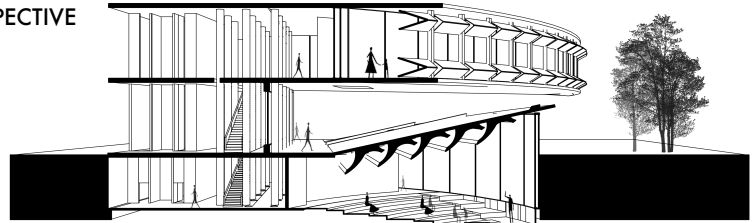

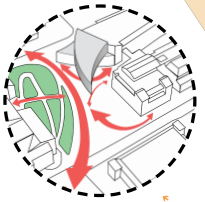
PROJECT STATEMENT

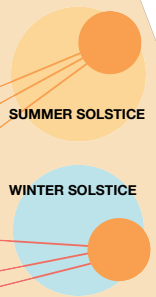
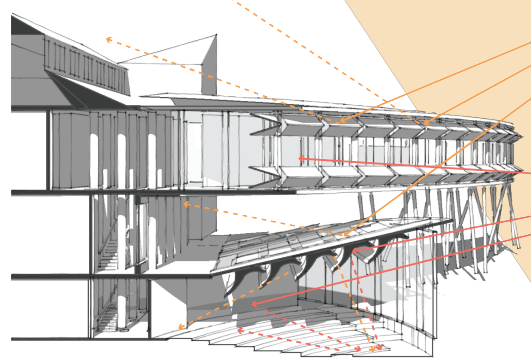

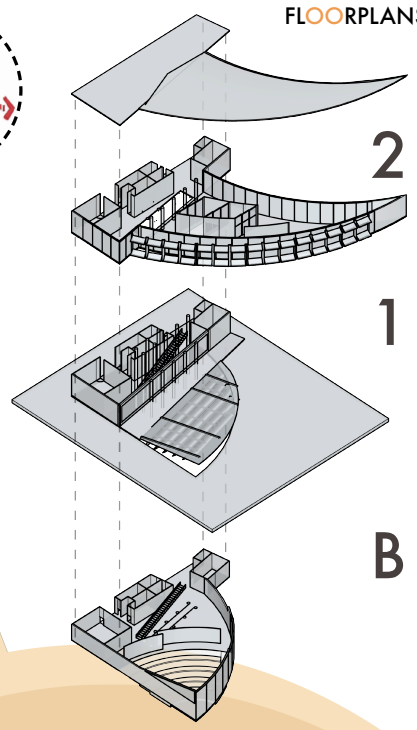
