

## Spring Semester 2006 Registration/Academic Calendar (Archived 3/2/06)

**NOTE:** Any student who completes registration agrees to pay the University of Colorado at Boulder all charges on their account when due. (See the bursar's [tuition and fee information](#))

October 24-28 (Mon.-Fri.)	Spring 2006 course reservation registration period for eligible students. (See <a href="#">Course Reservation</a> )
October 31 (Mon.) - November 27 (Sun.)	Spring 2006 registration time assignments for students enrolled during fall 2005. For best course selection, register as soon as possible after your time assignment begins. Continuing students can register through January 12.
November 28 (Mon.) - January 12 (Thurs.)	Schedule adjustment for continuing degree students who have registered for spring semester and registration for continuing students who have not yet registered.  Spring 2006 registration for eligible new and readmitted students who have confirmed with admissions.
December 16 (Fri.)	<b>Deadline</b> to update your billing and permanent addresses to ensure that your spring 2006 bill is mailed to the correct address.
December 19-20 (Mon.-Tues.)	Bills mailed to the billing addresses of all students who register by December 16. If no billing address is on record, bills are mailed to the permanent address. (Due on January 25.)
January 6 (Fri.)	<b>Deadline (midnight) for continuing students to withdraw from the university and receive a full refund of the \$200 enrollment deposit, less any outstanding charges.</b> (This deadline to withdraw and not forfeit the deposit also applies to students planning to go on the Time Out Program.) New and readmitted students are not eligible for a refund. (See <a href="#">Withdrawal</a> )
January 9 (Mon.)	Bills mailed to the billing addresses of all students who register December 17 through January 6. If no billing address is on record, bills are mailed to the permanent address.
January 12 (Thurs.)	<b>Deadline (6:00 p.m.) for ALL students, both undergraduate and graduate, to register for spring</b>

	<p><b>courses. Registration must be completed by 6:00 p.m. on this day to be guaranteed enrollment for spring semester.</b> After this date, registration is on a space-available basis, and a <b>\$50 late fee</b> is charged. (See <a href="#">Late Registration</a>)</p>
<p><b>January 13 (Fri.)</b></p>	<p><b>Drop/add time assignments begin.</b> (See <a href="#">Drop/Add</a>)</p> <p>ACCESS registration begins. (See <a href="#">ACCESS</a>)</p> <p>Bills mailed to the billing addresses of all students who register January 7-12. If no billing address is on record, bills are mailed to the permanent address.</p>
<p><b>January 15 (Sun.)</b></p>	<p><b>Drop/add time assignments continue.</b> (See <a href="#">Drop/Add</a>)</p> <p>Faculty/staff registration begins.</p>
<p><b>January 16 (Mon.)</b></p>	<p>Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday. No classes. University closed.</p>
<p><b>January 17 (Tues.)</b></p>	<p><b>Classes begin.</b></p>
<p><b>January 23-24 (Mon.-Tues.)</b></p>	<p>Space-available registration for Senior Citizens Auditors Program, Koenig Alumni Center, 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.; continues on Tuesday, January 24, 9:00 a.m. to noon. (See <a href="#">Other Types of Registration</a>)</p>
<p><b>January 25 (Wed.)</b></p>	<p><b>Add Deadline: Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to add a course,</b> including independent study and thesis, without the instructor's signature. After this date, the instructor's signature is required on a special action form to add a course (through February 3). <b>NOTE:</b> After 5:00 p.m. on this date, web registration is only available for dropping courses (through 5:00 p.m. on February 1, the drop deadline). (See <a href="#">Drop/Add</a>)</p> <p><b>Wait List Deadline: Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to add name to a course wait list.</b> (See <a href="#">Wait Lists</a>)</p> <p><b>Tuition Payment Deadlines: Deadline to pay full tuition and fees (or first payment of two-payment plan). Due before 6:00 p.m. if paid in person or mailed, or before midnight using the internet payment option.</b> No grace period. (See the bursar billing channel under the financial tab on CUConnect or <a href="#">Tuition and Fees</a>)</p> <p><b>Deadline</b> to sign up for the two-payment plan before midnight via CUConnect. No grace period.</p>

	<p><b>Deadline</b> (5:00 p.m.) to select or waive university sponsored health plan at Wardenburg Health Center or by midnight on CUConnect.</p> <p><b>Deadline</b> (5:00 p.m.) for private scholarship checks to be received in the financial aid Scholarship Office to avoid late and service charges.</p>
<b>February 1 (Wed.)</b>	<p><b>Drop Deadline: Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to drop a course</b> without the instructor's signature, without being assessed tuition and fees for that course, and without a W grade appearing on the transcript. After this date, the instructor's signature is required on a special action form and students must be passing the course to drop it. (See <a href="#">Drop/Add</a>) No refunds for tuition or fees are given for courses dropped after this date.</p> <p><b>Deadline</b> (5:00 p.m.) to petition to waive UCSU student fees.</p> <p><b>Deadline</b> to request a refund of any student opportunities fees you selected. (See <a href="#">Student Opportunities Fees</a>)</p> <p><b>Deadline</b> (5:00 p.m.) to withdraw from the university and only be assessed a \$200 withdrawal processing fee. After this date, 100 percent of tuition and fees is due for students who withdraw unless there are extenuating circumstances. (See <a href="#">Withdrawal</a>)</p>
<b>February 3 (Fri.)</b>	<p><b>Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to add a course without petitioning your dean. NOTE:</b> Instructors' signature is required on a special action form to add a course. In general, instructors only approve an add if students have been regularly attending and there's space in the course. (See <a href="#">Drop/Add</a>)</p> <p><b>Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to change variable-credit hours, pass/fail, and no-credit status on courses</b> without petitioning your dean. After the deadline, petitions will only be accepted if there are extenuating circumstances. (See <a href="#">Credit and Grading options</a>)</p>
<b>February 15 (Wed.)</b>	<p><b>Deadline (5:00 p.m.)</b> to withdraw from the university and be eligible to petition to be assessed 40 percent of full tuition and fees (instead of being assessed 100 percent of full tuition and fees). (See <a href="#">Withdrawal</a>)</p>
<b>February 24 (Fri.)</b>	<p><b>Deadline</b> for students who have three or more final exams</p>

	on the same day for spring semester to make arrangements to change their final exam schedule. (See <a href="#">Calendars and Schedules</a> )
<b>March 1 (Wed.)</b>	<p><b>Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to drop a course without petitioning the dean's office.</b> (See <a href="#">Drop/Add</a>)</p> <p><b>Deadline</b> to pay unpaid balance (including two-payment plan). Due 5:00 p.m. if paid in person or mailed, or before midnight using the internet payment option. No grace period. (See bursar billing channel under the financial tab on CUConnect and/or <a href="#">Tuition and Fees</a>)</p> <p><b>Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to turn in application(s) for the Course Forgiveness pilot program for spring semester.</b> (See <a href="#">Course Forgiveness</a>)</p> <p><b>Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to withdraw from the university and be eligible to petition to be assessed 60 percent of full tuition and fees (instead of being assessed 100 percent of full tuition and fees).</b> (See <a href="#">Withdrawal</a>)</p> <p><b>Deadline (5:00 p.m.) to turn in Time Out Program (TOP) applications to the registrar's office and be assured a continuing student registration time assignment for summer and/or fall semester 2006.</b> (See <a href="#">Time Out Program</a>)</p>
<b>March 8 (Wed.)</b>	<p><b>Summer 2006 registration begins for continuing degree students enrolled during spring 2006.</b></p> <p><b>Fall 2006 course listings available on the Web (tentative date).</b></p>
<b>March 13 (Mon.)</b>	Summer 2006 registration begins for eligible new and readmitted students and for nondegree students.
<b>March 20-30 (Mon.-Thurs.)</b>	Fall 2006 course reservation registration period for eligible students. (See <a href="#">Course Reservation</a> )
<b>March 27-31 (Mon.-Fri.)</b>	Spring break. No classes. University closed on Friday.
<b>April 3-30 (Mon.-Sun.)</b>	Fall 2006 registration period for continuing degree students enrolled during spring 2006.
<b>May 1 (Mon.)</b>	Fall 2006 registration begins for eligible new and readmitted students.
<b>May 5 (Fri.)</b>	Last day of classes for spring 2006.

	<p>Last day for students to withdraw from the university for spring semester. Students in the colleges/schools of Architecture, Education, Engineering, Journalism, Law, MBA and Music must have their dean's permission to withdraw. (See <a href="#">Withdrawal</a>)</p> <p>Last day for students to turn in Time Out Program (TOP) applications to the registrar's office for spring semester. (See <a href="#">Time Out Program</a>)</p>
<b>May 6-11 (Sat.-Thurs.)</b>	Final exams for spring 2006. (There are no exams on Sunday, May 7.) (See <a href="#">Calendars and Schedules</a> )
<b>May 11 (Thurs.)</b>	Last day to dispute tuition and fee charges for spring withdrawals. (See <a href="#">Tuition Dispute</a> )
<b>May 12 (Fri.)</b>	Spring 2006 commencement, Folsom Stadium, 8:30 a.m.
<b>May 15 (Mon.) - June 2 (Fri.)</b>	Summer 2006 Maymester session.
<b>May 29 (Mon.)</b>	Memorial Day holiday. No classes. University closed.
<b>June 5 (Mon.)</b>	Summer 2006 classes begin for first five-week, eight-week, and ten-week sessions.
<b>July 4 (Tues.)</b>	Independence Day holiday. No classes. University closed.
<b>July 11 (Tues.)</b>	Summer 2006 classes begin for second five-week session.
<b>August 12 (Sat.)</b>	Official summer 2006 graduation date. <b>No summer ceremony.</b>
<b>August 28 (Mon.)</b>	Fall 2006 classes begin.
<b>September 4 (Mon.)</b>	Labor Day Holiday. No classes. University closed.
<b>September 6 (Wed.)</b>	First fall tuition due date.
<b>November 17 (Fri.)</b>	Last day of classes prior to Fall Break
<b>November 20-22 (Mon.-Wed.)</b>	Fall Break. No classes. (University remains open.)
<b>November 23-24 (Thurs.-Fri.)</b>	Thanksgiving holiday. No classes. University closed.
<b>December 15 (Fri.)</b>	Last day of fall 2006 classes.
<b>December 16-21 (Sat.-Thurs.)</b>	Final exams for fall 2006. (There are no exams on Sunday, December 17.)
